

Pagosa Area Water and Sanitation District (PAWSD)
High Efficiency¹ Toilet² Rebate Program 2012 Guidelines



- **Rebates are offered on a first come, first serve basis and are subject to availability of funds.**
- **To ensure a rebate, check with PAWSD before you purchase the new toilet.**
- **Old toilets cannot be reused.** Participants agree to remove all hardware (to the greatest extent possible) and properly dispose of their old toilets at the PAWSD facility (100 Lyn Avenue) or provide proof of disposal.
- Participants must be residential or commercial PAWSD water customers, with current and non-delinquent account(s).
- **High efficiency toilets are defined as toilets that use 1.28 gallons per flush (gpf) or less.** The high efficiency toilet(s) being purchased must replace existing toilet(s) using 1.6 gpf or more; generally, homes built before 1994³ have higher than 1.6 gpf toilets.
- The high efficiency toilet(s) installed must be new.
- **High efficiency toilets receive a \$75 rebate.**
- Receipt must clearly show the fixture purchased.
- Rebate amount is not to exceed the cost of the toilet. Toilet price includes the tank and bowl only. Purchase price excludes such things as toilet seat, wax ring, bolts and sales tax.
- Participants must be home or business owners. Rental units may qualify; however, the rental facility owner must complete the application.
- Residential accounts may qualify for up to two toilets per program year. Upon approval, commercial facilities may qualify for more than two toilets.
- **Rebates are issued as a credit** applied to the PAWSD service account where the high efficiency toilet is installed.
- Rebates are issued monthly at the end of each billing cycle.
- Installation may be done by the home/business owner (if qualified) and/or by a participating licensed plumber.
- Installation site may be subject to inspection. If a property for which a rebate has been issued is found upon inspection to have a non-qualifying product and/or installation, the amount rebated will be charged back to the PAWSD account which was originally credited.
- Installation costs are not rebated.
- The program applies to products purchased from January 1, 2012 through December 15, 2012 or until program funds are exhausted.
- Incomplete paperwork, including applications lacking a signature or a copy of the purchase receipt(s) will be denied.
- PAWSD assumes no liability for any loss, damage or expense in connection with the materials, workmanship or fitness of the high efficiency toilets, their installation, or use. PAWSD makes no representation or warranty of the high efficiency toilets.
