- We'll meet at the Community Center at 5:30 p.m. and leave promptly at 5:45 p.m. after arranging car pools.
- When we start, sack lunches will be given out. Due to a full itinerary, we won't have time for a full picnic but will have dessert at the West Fork Campground.

5:30 p.m. Meet at the Ross Aragon Community Center Parking Lot and arrange car pooling. Everyone will receive a sack lunch there to eat along the way.

5:45 p.m. Depart for PAWSD (Pagosa Area Water and Sand District) municipal water take out (10.8 miles) -- Learn about water quality, water supply for the area, etc. *Directions: Go east on Highway #160 towards Wolf Creek. There will be a CDOT bldg on the right side. There is a small area next to that for parking. Cross the highway and make your way under the bridge - that is where the main gate is and will be unlocked.*

6:30 p.m. Drive up to the Wolf Creek Pass west overlook (6.6 miles) – learn about the USFS-defined Outstandingly Remarkable Value of “geology” from Glenn Raby (retired USFS geologist)

7:30 p.m. Drive to West Fork Campground (4.0 miles from the Wolf Creek overlook) – Through informal discussions, we will cover and discuss other issues the Working Group is talking about..... dessert will be served!

8:15 p.m. **Only if there is time**, we'll drive up the East Fork Road (it is 5.3 miles to East Fork entrance from the entrance to the West Fork)
